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The Correspondent, Sri Kakatiya Primary School Jammikunta, Mandal Jammikunta has submitted proposals for grant of Extension of Temporary Recognition classes Nursery - V EM with addl section B,C and D for the year 2025-2026 to 2029-2030.

The Mandal Educational Officer concerned has verified the Proposals with reference to the conditions laid down in the Recognition orders and G.O Ms. No. 1/Edn Date : 01.01.1994 and subsequent Government orders submitted a detailed report through the letter under reference 5th cited.


After careful examination of the proposals of the Correspondent and based on the recommendations of the Mandal Educational Officer, Jammikunta the District Educational Officer, Karimnagar is pleased to accord Extension of Temporary Recognition for Classes Nursery - V EM with addl section B,C and D for the year 2025-2026 to 2029-2030 in respect of Sri Kakatiya Primary School Jammikunta situated at H.No.6-2-72/1,2,3,4, Jammikunta, Mandal Jammikunta subject to fulfillment of the following conditions.

1. The above permission is accorded purely on a temporary basis and is subjected to the reports of Sate Level Inspection and Vigilance Committee fulfilling of all the Pre-requisite condition under AP/Telangana Education Act 1982 and if later found that, the school has not fulfilled any pre-requisites as stipulated, the Renewal Recognition now being given is liable to be withdrawn at any time.
2. That the society shall abide to the rules and regulations made in the Government orders 1st cited and subsequent orders. That the Educational Institution shall serve the needs of the locality more particularly.
3. That the Society shall provide the necessary amenities like accommodation sanitary facilities, drinking water facilities, furniture, library, laboratory, equipment play field required staff as per the staff pattern another facilities.
4. That the permission is accorded to Avirineni Sudhakar Rao Educational Society, H.No.6-2-49/1 Ganeshnagar Jammikunta, Mandal : Jammikunta Regd.No.953 of 2011.
5. The permission is accorded to run the school in the locality and there shall not be any change in the premises of locality specified in the orders.
6. The management should follow the G.O Ms.No. 22 Date:-18.07.2017 i.e, regarding weight of the school bag.
7. That the administrative report and the audited statement of accounts of the school duly attested by the Chartered Accountant for every financial year shall be submitted to the District Educational Officer, latest by September.
8. The management has to follow the Government norms from time to time, for collection of fee from students.
9. The Educational Society shall not use the premises building, play ground and vacant site belongs to the institution for any purpose other than the educational activities and conducting authorized examinations without permission of the District Educational Officer.
10. The Management should follow the guidelines issued in G.O.Ms No. 36 School Education (General) Department Dated : 16.12.2017 for the safety and security of the children in the schools.
11. The Management should pay the mandate taxes due to the concerned departments as per schedule fixed by the Government.
12. The school shall follow the traffic and safety guidelines indicated by the police and fire services department
13. The School shall have "First aid-Kit and the teachers shall be trained in first aid.
14. That any children studies in recognized school of other state/countries affiliated to the bodies recognized by the State/Central Government shall not be admitted without prior permission of the District Educational Officer/Director of School Education.
15. That the management shall not collect any fees or donations either in cash or kind other than the fees prescribed by the governing body from pupils or parents or any other person or on their behalf for any purpose.
16. That educational agency shall not force any member of the staff or students of the institutions to take part in the religious discourses and preaching of religion irrespective of whether they belong to the same belief or not.

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17. If the Management provides transportation, it is the responsibility of the Management to submit fitness certificates of their buses every year regularly to the District Educational Officer to have Skilled, Trained, Licensed and Healthy Driver. If any deviation in the matter, they will be personally held responsible.
18. The Correspondent should submit renewal of Recognition proposals before 90 days of the expiry of Renewal Recognition.
19. The Educational Agency should implement the Model Education code prepare by National University for Educational Planning and Administration in 2015.
20. That the Educational Agency shall not permit the students of any D.Ed/B.Ed College or College of Physical Education or any teacher training institution to have teaching practice without the permission of the District Educational Officer.
21. Proper and adequate parking area for vehicles shall be provided transporting the children to and from the school.
22. Proper and adequate safety measures shall be taken for children within the school campus and also near the school premises.
23. The Parents Teachers Associations meeting shall be conducted to sensitize the Parents on the safety of the children.
24. The school shall constitute committees for redressal of the Public/Staff/Parents/Students grievances, Internal Complaints Committee on Sexual Harassment and committees under POSCL (Protection of Children from Sexual Offence) Act 2012 and details of these committees along with contact details shall be displayed prominently on school notice board and conspicuously on the school website for the information of all the stakeholders.
25. That the institution shall adopt the curriculum and syllabus prescribed from time to time.
26. The School timing, Vocational and mid-term holidays shall be followed prescribed by the Government from time to time.
27. As per the staffing pattern the qualified staff within the age limits prescribed by the Government for Government Employees shall be appointed.
28. Appointment of Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff within the age limits prescribed by the Government for Government Employees shall be appointed.
29. That the Governing Body/Staff Selection Committee shall be furnished to the District Educational Officer every year.
30. The approval of the correspondent ship should be get approved by the competent authority.
31. That the pay structure/fee structure fixed by the governing body shall be get approved by the District Educational Officer every year.
32. That the school shall not be closed without giving prior notice both to the Parents/District Educational Officer and to the competent authority concerned at least 6 months before.
33. Next higher classes additional sections should not be opened without prior permission from the competent authority.
34. That all conditions prescribed in G.O. Ms.No. 1 Dt. 1-1-1994 & G.O. Ms.No. 41 Dt. 11-5-2006 and other orders issued by the Government time to time. Which are not specified in this proceeding shall be completed with.
35. The Correspondent is informed that the institution as founded /permitted by department as per chapter (1) section 2 of RTI Act 2005. The management should abide the rules of RTI Act 2005.

The Correspondent is requested to submit compliance report on fulfillment of conditions prescribed, within three months through Inspecting Officer concerned without fail. The receipt of the proceedings shall be acknowledged.
